



A Message from our Executive Director Phil Jenni Regarding COVID-19

I'm glad you are interested in joining us this summer. We are accepting applicants and have rolled out several new protocols to help ensure the safety of our staff and volunteers.

Our volunteers, staff and interns are like family and we want you and your loved ones to remain healthy. At the same time, if COVID-19 spreads through the WRC, it will have severe consequences for our patients. We are hoping everyone takes this seriously and stays healthy.

One of these protocols is that we are foregoing group orientations for now. Once your application has been processed, we'll be in touch with the next steps.

We ask that you do not come into WRC if you have been traveling, been in a large group, have potential exposure or are not feeling well in any way (not just displaying COVID-19 symptoms).

Additionally, we are scheduling reduced staff in the building, and volunteers are being asked to work in small groups maintaining a 6' radius from each other at all times. We are sanitizing building areas throughout the day and between shifts, and making sure you have access to hand sanitizer and personal protection equipment (PPE) while on your shifts.

Biosecurity in the hospital is always a primary concern, so many of these expanded protocols come naturally to our staff and volunteers.

Since this is a fluid situation you can expect updates from us as things change and we adapt to new circumstances.

In the meantime, go ahead and complete your application process. We're looking forward to having you join us this summer.
